Hi Tom -

According to our listing expert:

Phentermine is listed in 261.33 under the name alpha,alpha-dimethylphenethylamine as P046, with a CAS number 122-09-8.

However, the listing does not include the term "and salts", so I would say that Phentermine HCL is not listed. This was the principle used for EPA's policy that epinepherine is listed as P042, but that the salts are not covered by the listing.

According to the original background documents, phentermine

(alpha,alpha-dimethylphenethylamine) was listed in 261.33 due to its acute toxicity towards humans. There was no indication that EPA intended to include any of the salts (e.g., the HCL salt) in the listing for phentermine.
